Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion: We Stand Beneath the Cross

We hold palm branches in our hands today. We say, "Hosanna, a word that means, Be now our Savior" Christ's entry into Jerusalem is the sign of our hope of entry into the heavenly Jerusalem.

A man with leprosy came before Jesus and was healed. But Jesus told him, "See that you say nothing to anyone about this." A deaf man came to the Lord. Jesus said, "Ephphathat, Be Opened" and the man was able to hear. Then Jesus told him, "Say nothing about this to anyone." A blind man had his sight returned, and, similarly, Jesus said to him, "Keep this quiet--don't even enter the villages."

Jesus died on the Cross, and a pagan, a Roman centurion, made the announcement, "Surely this is the Son of God."

To understand who Jesus is, we have to recognize the Cross.

To recognize how much God loves us, we have to realize the extent of his suffering for us.

To realize what it means to be followers of Jesus, we have to join him on the Cross.

We stand beneath the Cross. With Mary and John. The crowd is terrible. They yell insults at the Kindest One. This is what he gets, we get, for not being like everyone else. Their ridicule hurts Mary and John and Us.

Escaping into materialism, their silence laughs at the poverty of belonging to a Crucified King They laugh at Mary and John And Us.

We stand beneath the Cross with Mary and John. His pain is unbearable. It is hard to look at the Innocent One. But he looks down from his pulpit, And loves Mary and John, And Us.

SACRAMENTS & REGISTRATION

PARISH REGISTRATION:

All are welcome! Any letter concerning sponsorship for the sacraments or testimonial letters will only be issued to registered parishioners of 6+ months. Please register in the rectory.

BAPTISM:.

To have your child baptized in the Diocese of Brooklyn and Queens, you must show:

- 1. Proof that you live in the geographical boundaries of the Church you wish to have the baby baptized.(e.g. electric bill). If you live outside the boundaries of the Church you wish to have your baby baptized, you must get a permission letter from the Catholic church closest to where you live granting you permission to have your baby baptized outside of the geographical area.
 - 2. Your baby is allowed <u>one</u> God mother and <u>one</u> God father, one must be Catholic, practicing their faith (letter from the Church stating this), and have their confirmation certificate. The baby can be baptized with one Catholic god parent.
 - 3. One parent must be baptized Catholic and have their baptism certificate, First Communion or Confirmation as proof.
 - 4. Once these requirements are fulfilled, we encourage you to call and set a date. Children 7 & under can be baptized w/o CCD classes.

RCIA

RCIA stands for RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS and is composed of a series of sessions bringing people together to experience the prayer life of the church as well as learn about its doctrines and teachings. Using the readings from the Bible which we hear daily at Mass, the Sacred Liturgy as well as the Catechism of the Catholic Church, teens and adults who have not yet done so prepare themselves to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation & Holy Eucharist.

RCIA is offered in Spanish, Kreyol & English and is for people who:

- Were baptized in the Catholic Church but have not received the sacrament of Confirmation, First Holy Communion or First Confession
- Were baptized in another Christian denomination and wish to join the Catholic Church
- Were never baptized & wish to fully worship in the Catholic Church
 - Wants to know more about what it means to be Catholic?

LENTEN REQUIREMENTS

In our preparation for Easter, the Church invites us to observe the penitential and grace filled season of Lent which commences on February 14,2024 with the observance of Ash Wednesday.

Abstinence— All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting - All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

Easter Duty— After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter Season, unless, for a good reason, it is fulfilled at another time of the year. By special permission in the United States the period for fulfilling this precept has been extended to include the period from the First Sunday of Lent (February 18,2024) to the celebration of Pentecost (May 19,2024).

The Solemnity of St. Joseph: The Solemnity of St. Joseph should be observed with proper solemnity even though it falls within the season of Lent.

Reconciliation Monday: Our diocese will once again celebrate Reconciliation Monday on March 25, 2024, the Monday of Holy Week. After having reached the age of discretion, members of the faithful are bound to confess once a year grave sins which have not already been absolved.,

This lasted for four years terminating with ordination on 19th July 1997. He ministered in St. Peter's Parish, Vakpo from 1997 to 1999 and Immaculate Conception Parish, Kpando. He then went to OLA Secondary School, Ho from 1999-2005.

He had further studies in the University of Education, Winneba from 2005-2009 and then was in St. Mary's Minor Seminary, Lolobias as teacher then rector from 2009-2023.

He retired on April 9,2023 from Ghana Education Service. A few months after retirement the bishop offered him the opportunity to the United States for a pastoral experience.

The Diocese of Brooklyn assigned him here in St.

Matthew/St. Gregory/ Our Lady of Charity. May God bless him in his ministry here with us.
